SAFEGUARING: OPERATION ENCOMPASS

Since 2021, we have been part of a joint operation involving Birmingham Children's Trust, Birmingham City Council and West Midlands Police, known as **Operation Encompass**. Operation Encompass has been established to help schools provide in-school support to children who have been present at, exposed to or involved in any domestic abuse incident. We know that children can be significantly harmed, physically and/or emotionally, during these situations, and that it also negatively affect their learning and behavior in class. Therefore, as part of the Operation Encompass procedure, and to help mitigate the resulting negative impact, the school receives a confidential phone call or email from West Midlands before 9am the morning after a child or young person has been witness to, or involved in, any reported domestic abuse incident.

As you are already aware, in school we have a dedicated and child-focused Safeguarding Team. They are specially trained to effectively use the information the Police share, in confidence, and enable the school to provide the right support to any child and their family. We always endeavor to offer the best support possible to our pupils and believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
