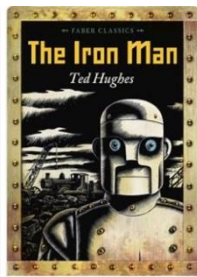
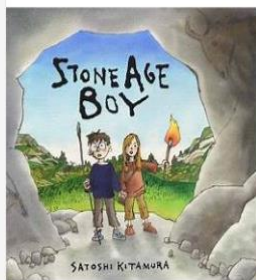

Topic: A Journey Through Time

History

Children will learn about the Stone Age to Iron Age (Stone Age, Bronze Age, Iron Age and Celtic Culture).

Science

The topics this term are ‘Rocks and Fossils’ and ‘Animals including Humans’.

Maths

In Maths this term, we will be focusing on the following topics:

Number: Multiplication and Division (B)

Reasoning about multiplication

Multiply a 2-digit by a 1-digit (exchange and no exchange)

Divide a 2-digit by a 1-digit (with remainders)

Measurement: Length and Perimeter

Measure in millimeters, centimetres and metres

Equivalent lengths

Add, subtract and compare lengths

Measure and calculate length

Number: Fractions (A)

Unit and non-unit fractions

Count in fractions on a number line

Equivalent fractions

Measurement: Mass and Capacity

Measure mass in grams and kilograms

Add, subtract and compare mass

Measure capacity and volume in millilitres and litres

Add, subtract and compare capacity and volume

Design and Technology

Children will learn about ‘Seasonal Eating’.

Computing

Children will learn about ‘Online Safety’, Computing systems and networks: Emailing’, and ‘Computing systems and networks: Journey inside a computer’.

PE

The topics for this term are: Gymnastics, Cricket, Circuit Training and Basketball.

Art

Children will be looking at pre-historic paintings and mixed media.

Music

Children will learn a song called ‘Three Little Birds’, ‘The Dragon Song’ and learn how to play the Glockenspiel.

MFL

In Modern Foreign Language, children will be introduced to a new language: Spanish.

RE

The two themes we will be looking at this term are ‘Jesus Miracles’ and ‘Easter’.

For the topics, the children will be exploring two key questions: ‘Could Jesus heal people? Were these miracles or is there some other explanation?’ and ‘What is good about Good Friday?’

RSHE
