Children are admitted in the September after their fourth birthday and leave seven years later, at the age of eleven.

Children are admitted in this order of priority:-

- 1) Children with older brothers or sisters already at the school who will still be there when they start school themselves.
- 2) Children who are Church of England denomination.
- 3) Children who live nearest the school.
