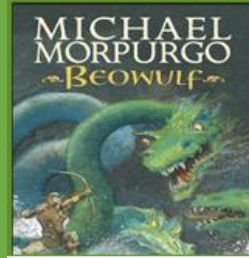


Anglo-Saxons and Vikings
