There is no fixed minimum age to play, and children often share games and social spaces with much older users. This mix of ages, combined with user-generated content and social features such as chat and voice chat, means children's experiences can vary widely. Parents should always have insight into what their child is actually seeing, doing, or who they are interacting with.
